




City of Cambridge Population Trend: 1950 - 2017





City of Cambridge Diversity: 2011 - 2015





East Cambridge Population Trend: 1950 - 2010





East Cambridge Population Change: 1990 - 2010





City of Cambridge and East Cambridge Foreign Born: 1950 – 2016






The great majority of 2010 residents claim ancestry in other groups – 78%.


In 1980 only 18% of residents did not belong one of the top four ancestry groups
















East Cambridge Diversity: 2012 - 2016




